Whereas, the Town currently has a 2023 Western Star Tandem on order to be built with completion and delivery of sometime late spring 2023.

Whereas, the Town has lost the use of one of the existing fleet trucks and is in an emergency need to replace it to be able to provide public safety and for the clearing of public highways;

Whereas the Town Highway Superintendent has located and inspected a Used 2014 Western Star that could fulfill the Town's needs:

Therefore, the Town Board does hereby declare we must override the lengthy, time prohibitive bidding process as set forth in our Procurement Policy for consideration of purchase of said 2014 Western Star Truck.

Discussion: Board members had lengthy discussion on the purchase of the 2014 versus the 2008 truck owned by the Town of Schroon.
